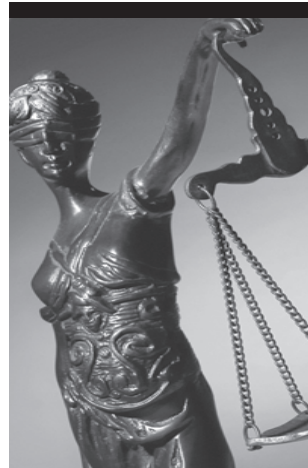

AND MOOSE PROCLAMATION SUMMARY**

**The North Dakota Game and Fish Department announces the following summary of regulations and changes for the 2020 Bighorn Sheep, Elk and Moose hunting seasons.**

- Licenses will be issued by a lottery procedure through the Department.
- Applications may be submitted online or by phone (general lottery). **The deadline for submitting online or phone applications is March 25, 2020.**

**SUMMARY OF CHANGES FROM LAST YEAR**

- A bighorn sheep hunting season is scheduled to open in 2020, unless there is a recurrence of bacterial pneumonia. Applicants may apply for a license at this time, but not in a specific unit. The status of the bighorn sheep season will be determined by September 1.
- Total elk licenses increased by 45 to 523.
- Total moose licenses decreased by 5 to 474.
- All moose licensees and Unit E1E, E1W, E2, and E6 elk licensees may hunt during both the Bow Season and the Regular Season until license is filled. Moose Hunting Units M1C and M4 will remain closed in 2020.
